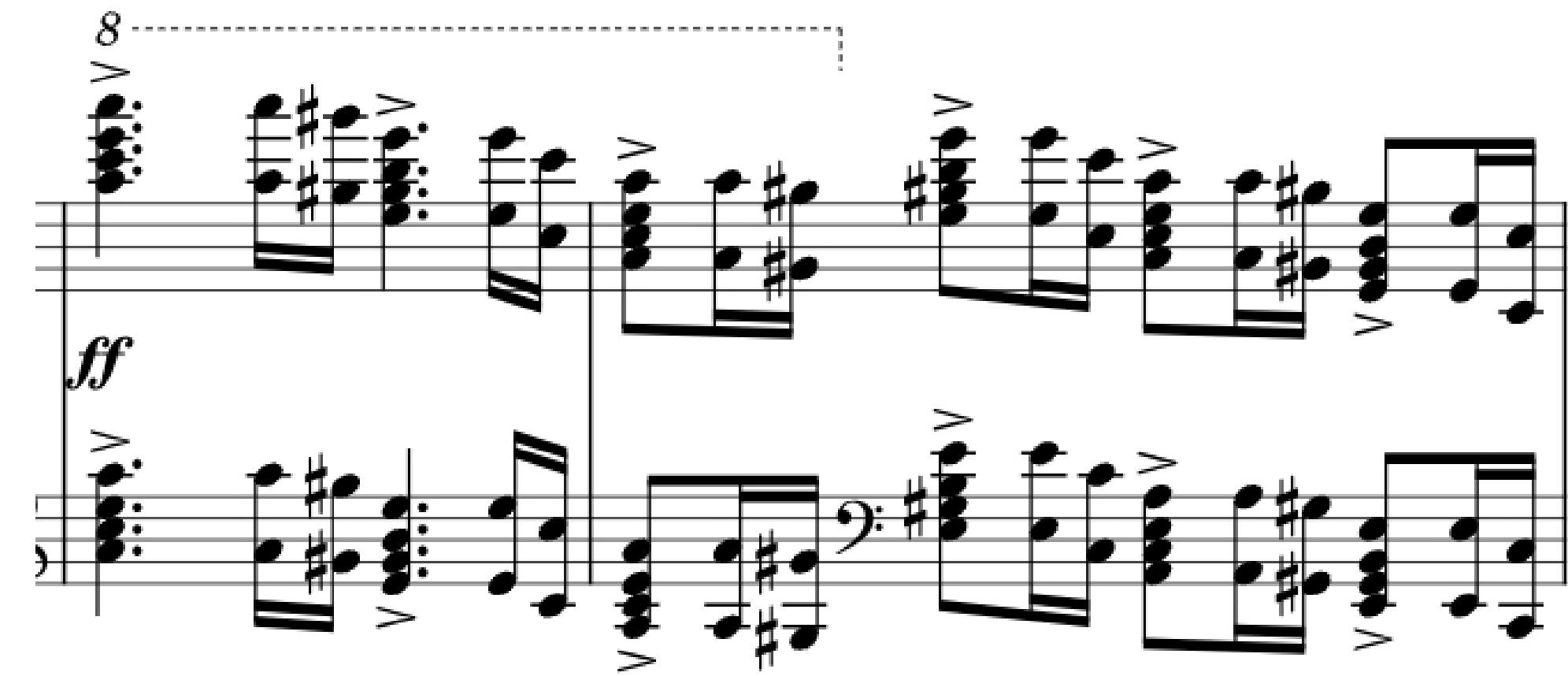


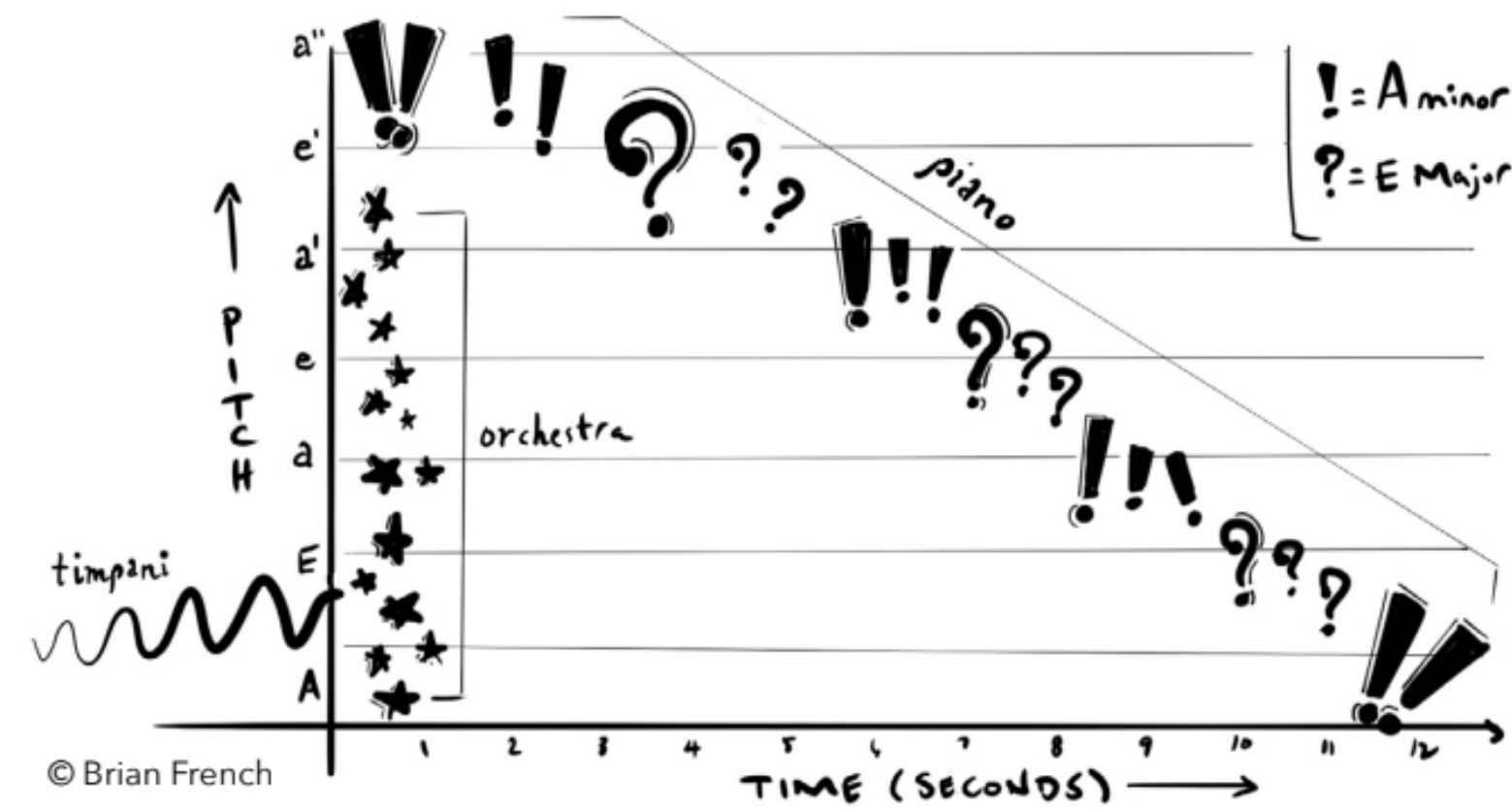
MAKING A GRAPHIC SCORE
