# JAEDEN IZIK-DZURKO

**Jaeden Izik-Dzurko** is the 2024 Leeds International Piano Competition winner and recipient of the Dame Fanny Waterman Gold Medal. Hailed for his expressive depth and technical brilliance, the 25-year-old Canadian pianist has performed at Carnegie Hall, Wigmore Hall, and major venues across Europe, North America, and Asia.

He has appeared with orchestras including the Royal Liverpool Philharmonic, Orchestre symphonique de Montréal, and National Arts Centre Orchestra. A Borletti-Buitoni Trust Fellow, Jaeden's debut EP with Warner Classics was released in 2024. He currently studies in Germany and Italy.

Jaeden Izik-Dzurko has been praised for his extraordinary musical maturity, technical finesse, and deeply communicative performances. Winner of the coveted Dame Fanny Waterman Gold Medal at the 2024 Leeds International Piano Competition, he also became the first Canadian-born Grand Prize Laureate at the 2024 Concours musical international de Montréal.

He has captivated audiences in concert halls around the world, and critics have celebrated his ability to blend power with poetic sensitivity. Gramophone described his playing as exhibiting “**extraordinary maturity and control**,” while iNews highlighted his “**excellent control and sensitivity**,” leaving a “**lasting impression**” on listeners. His interpretations reveal a rare combination of structural clarity, depth, and emotional insight, creating performances that feel both personal and profound.

Whether in solo recitals or with orchestras, Jaeden’s artistry consistently resonates with audiences, reaffirming his status as one of the most compelling and distinctive pianists of his generation.
